Call to order	Meeting was called to order at 6:50 p.m. at the Theresa Sebestyen home.	
Review/Approve Minutes	November 8, 2016 Executive Committee Meeting minutes were discussed and approved with minor changes.	
Treasurer's Report	Checking balance as of January 1, 2017 = \$95,207.51 (includes held funds for various clubs and past graduation legacy gifts)	
	 Activities: A Box Top check was received for \$1,611.30 (for the period March 2016 -November 2016). Box Tops send checks semi-annually. Fun Run proceeds have come in and the numbers should be finalized by the January 26th meeting. A bill has been received for the balance and we need to confirm the correct amount to be paid. A check was received from Chipotle in the amount of \$317.80 for the December 6th Eat & Earn. A small number of monetary transactions occurred since the last meeting for Seat Saks, Movie Night, Spirit Wear & an APAWAZZ activity. Book Fair deposit was for \$5,508.12 which is expected to match the book fair bill 	
	Audit: Ann received the final audit report from Cathy Bartels for fiscal year 7/1/2015 to 6/30/16. The overall report was good with the following problems noted and future suggestions: Problems Noted: 1. Two payments to Matty's for same amount did not have supporting documentation. This was a split payment and was not a duplicate payment. 2. Raven was paid twice for Spiritwear and did not have supporting documentation. This was a duplicate payment and we have since been reimbursed by Raven for	
	the duplicate payment. Suggestions: 1. Write invoice number on the memo line of the check for payments when applicable. 2. Do not issue a check until all supporting documents are received. • Discussed having an audit done on a regular basis and what the appropriate frequency would be. No decision was made at this time on the frequency. • Ann has requested to purchase new supplies for organization of historical treasurer documents. This was unanimously approved.	

For Discussion	 Extra-Curricular Expenses- Theresa received an email from Katy outlining how co- curricular opportunities support our mission. Current co-curricular activities cost about \$10,000 per year. The H&S contribution of \$3500 for this school year will help subsidize the cost of advisers and coaches for these activities.
