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| Call to order | Meeting was called to order at 6:37 p.m. |
| Review/Approve <br> Minutes | March 10, 2015 Executive Committee Meeting minutes were discussed and approved with <br> no changes. March 17, 2015 meeting minutes were discussed and no changes made. |
| Treasurer's Report | Allison Giese shared notable changes since our last meeting: <br>  <br> REVENUE: |

- Box Tops earned $\$ 1,000$ over what was budgeted.
- The second Skate Night earned $\$ 78$.
- A check for around $\$ 800$ is coming from Matty's soon for money raised from September through May.
- Kwik Trip fundraiser earned $\$ 447$.


## EXPENSES:

- The spring dance was originally added as an expense, but it made $\$ 1,400$ ! We do still need to pay custodial fees out of that amount.
- High Interest Day expense will be offset by fees charged (which haven't been included yet)
- Musical expenses include flower/cookie sale (profit of \$220)
- Lighting was updated in gym for musical; may need to raise lighting and sound budget for some future maintenance and improvement expenses.
- We made an $\$ 1800$ donation to the school district to offset video conference costs.
- The sixth grade gift (from last year's graduating class) will be a bench in the courtyard for teachers and staff to use.
- We will do School Kidz next year, but not as a fundraiser. Colleen will email LouAnn Koppa and let her know not to add profit to the cost.

Expenses $=\$ 7,595.59$
Current checking account balance $=\$ 50,627.03$
Available cash $=\$ 24,463.04$
Alison went through the proposed budget for 2015-2016. Suggested changes include:

- For the Book Fair, add budget of $\$ 150$ to get new baskets (that hold books that students can buy for each teacher) plus $\$ 50$ for cash cushion.
- The spring dance will move to the revenue section for next year.
- Increase Fall Fest budget to $\$ 350$ (increased number of families attending)
- Home and School will use Scholastic dollars to give to new teachers to buy books,

|  | so don't need separate line item. <br> - We will keep miscellaneous line item of $\$ 150$ for office to use as special needs arise for students. Yvette Cunningham will reconcile amount at end of school year. <br> - Increase hospitality budge to hold staff social. <br> - Add $\$ 3300$ for Extended Learning Support <br> - Keep Artist-in-Residence as roll-over and look at again next year. |
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| Past Events | a. Market Day Pick-Up - Fri, March 13 ( $4^{\text {th }}$ grade), Fri, April 17 ( $5^{\text {th }}$ grade) <br> b. Spring Musical - Friday, March 27 <br> The musical went well and cookie and flower sales made $\$ 225$. <br> c. Book Fair - April 20-24 <br> We made $\$ 9,253$ in total sales. We found out that in the future, we can't give $20 \%$ off and a free book at the same time (the $20 \%$ off would now come out of our Scholastic dollars). Possibly we'll give a $\$ 5$ book in fall and $20 \%$ off in spring. We have $\$ 12,000$ left in Scholastic dollars. <br> d. Spring Dance - Saturday, April 25 Pam will give update at general meeting. <br> e. Staff Appreciation Week - May 4-8 Royce said it was a great week! |
| For Discussion | a. Home and School Room (follow up) <br> The room organization and moving of items went fine. <br> b. School Supplies for next year <br> Royce said that the school district is looking into centralizing some school supply purchasing (such as pencils, folders, markers, etc.). Parents will still purchase personal use items such as seat sacks or calculators. Royce will talk with LouAnn Koppa about SchoolPak contract. <br> c. Funding for In-School Field Trips There was discussion about ways to fund this and that money could be given to each grade level to offset expenses of field trips (For example, $\$ 2,100$ would give each grade level $\$ 300$, about $\$ 3$ per child). Each grade level could choose their field trip that would have expenses offset by Home and School. This could also be called Extended Learning Opportunities. <br> d. Cubs on the Prowl <br> Colleen, Rachel and Allison met with Shannon Achter and decided it would be best to move Cubs on the Prowl to a fall event, probably the last Friday in September ( $\left.25^{\text {th }}\right)$. Some ideas discussed included adding a silent auction (with experiences donated by teachers or families). Possibly fundraising at this event could go towards Extended Learning Opportunities. <br> e. Positions for next year <br> Kara heard back from about one-third of committee chairs. She will contact the rest again. Stacy, the Health Room coordinator, will be ending but is willing to help train next person. Kara will put this notice in Paw Prints. <br> f. Kwik Trip Carwash Fundraiser Colleen will check with Kathy on update. <br> g. Amazon Smiles <br> Amazon gives a percentage of purchase back to Elmwood. Families can link up with Amazon Prime account.
