Call to order	Meeting was called to order at 6:41 p.m.	
Review/Approve	Aug. 18, 2015 Executive Committee Meeting minutes were discussed and approved with

Treasurer's Report	Ann Szeflinski shared treasurer updates:	
	On income side, we received a check for \$220 from Matty's for sixth grade	
	graduation reimbursement (we overpaid for catering).	
	 We received our last two checks from Market Day for deposit. Ann would like to retire the Cart Mart line item and add a Seat Sack line item 	
	instead.	
	Ann shared a pie graph that graphically showed income and expenses. The	
	board agreed that we liked this and would like to showcase this at the opening	
	 meeting; possibly have it on a posterboard to display. Ann proposed changing the layout of the budget sheet – for events that have 	
	both expenses and income, show that in a new way (for example High Interest	
	Day brings in money but also has expenses).

	went well. Theresa sent out sign-up genius for people to sign up and families	
	responded. Theresa had kindergarten class lists and then color coded nametags for	
	kids (so parents and kids could see who was in their class).

Changes in Fundraising and Dates	 a. New Fundraiser, World's Finest Chocolates replacing Market Day Kara, Molly and Tonia Schmear met with Heather, our former Market Day rep. They learned that World's Finest Chocolates bought Market Day. We are guaranteed the same profits (\$1,372.50) that we made in 10 months through Market Day if we run one World's Finest Chocolates fundraiser. Their recommendation is to go with basic chocolate bar fundraiser. There is a 30 bar box (\$2 per piece) and 60 bar box (\$1 per piece). Two of them are completely nut free (made in different facility). We have to commit if we are doing this by end of September. b. Cubs on the Prowl
