

Executive Committee Meeting Minutes

November 12, 2013 7:00pm – 9:00pm Elmwood Library

- 1) **Call to order** at 6:40pm. In attendance: Colleen Tadych, Cathy Boerner, Alison Giese, Kathy Quandt and Royce Lindner(Principal)
- 2) **Review/Approve Minutes of Oct. 15, 2013** Executive Committee Meeting. Corrections made and minutes approved.

3) Financial Report

Mr. Lintz & Ms. Stelman used their \$200 each. The other teachers we will use Scholastic dollars and keep the \$400. Staff will make up a wish list and submit to Molly Carroll.

\$2,888 Profit from Entertainment Books. There was Internet Sales – Alison Giese will check with Tracy.

Expenses – Book Fair– there was a \$48 mistransaction. We didn't have enough to pay Scholastic because we were short. \$9,906.65 in Scholastic funds was made. Now we need to decide how to disperse. Will most go to the Library? Split the rest between teachers and expository materials.

Scholastic dollars can be used on a number of different things than just books(equipment, supplies)

Spiritwear – Collected \$4,600 from families but do not have invoice yet. It should zero out with a small profit.

Aritist in Residence was paid last week and was a big hit amongst students.

Fall Fest – Alison reports everything is good. There was \$29 in expenses. Water and Popcorn was sold to offset expenses. We still need Summary Reports at the Home and School meeting next week from the following committees and Colleen Tadych will contact them: Fall Fest, Artist in Residence, and Scholastic Bookfair.
