## ELMWOOD Home and School

Executive Committee Meeting Minutes<br>March 11, 2014<br>6:30pm - 8:30pm<br>Elmwood Library

1) Call to order at 6:40 pm. In attendance: Cathy Boerner, Colleen Tadych, Kathy Quandt, Alison Giese and Principal Royce Lindner
2) Review/Approve Minutes of January 14, 2014 Executive Committee Meeting - Minutes approved.

## 3) Treasurer's Report

A line item was added in Expenses for Building Equipment for $\$ 5,000$ for Risers and the Paper Roll holder. $\$ 43,000$ was added to the Playground amount as per budget approval. The cost of the Risers was less than expected, about $\$ 850$ less.

Principal Royce Lindner informed us that he has scheduled a BMX Bike Presentation for a spring assembly at the cost of $\$ 300$ (less than our budgeted amount) for two different sessions. Need to add a line item for Playground donations in amount of $\$ 15,000$ and record ongoing donations. To date, we have received @ $\$ 2,000$ in donations for Playground.

Royce has received a donation letter from Larry Lueck for Video Conferencing but has yet to receive a bill for it. We currently have $\$ 11,811.46$ in our account for expenditures this school year. Colleen Tadych voiced concern on how we could better make families aware about donations for the playground.

Need to advertise the Playground donation letter, pictures to Elmwords this week. Principal Lindner will notify Yvette to publish.
We will wait to publish our donation levels later on.
Chess Club is allowing us to run concessions and receive profits from the tournament on March $15^{\text {th }}$. We still need volunteers to staff the event.

Colleen Tadych has been in contact with Marie Collins regarding Box Tops for Education. Marie wants to get this going now, especially upon learning Ronald Reagan received $\$ 6,000$ and Holy Apostles $\$ 5,000$ from Box Tops. She has the following ideas to help increase awareness:
1.) Duct Tape Principal to the Wall
2.) Pizza/Cupcake Party for top earners
3.) Extra Recess by certain date for highest class totals
4.) Dye Principal Lindner's hair pink and wear a sandwich board during morning Drop-off and afternoon Pick-up advertising Box Tops
5.) Family who collects the most gets priority seating at a school event(Fine Arts Night, Musical, $6^{\text {th }}$ grade graduation)
6.) Family Pack of Fun - Items donated from businesses used as incentives for levels of donation.
7.) $\$ 10$ Gift cards at end of each quarter for students with most Box Tops (Royce has Marcus movie pass coupons - buy one, get one. Molly Carroll may also still have some Marcus tickets left to donate)

Ideas to advertise: Booth at beginning of school year(back to school day/night), Thermometer showing donation progress, Labelled Ziplock bags sent home to families to collect labels), place donation collection boxes in senior homes. Also, a dunk tank at assembly portion of High Interest Day for class with highest total.

## 4) Playground Update and Next Steps

The most recent drawing/photo from Gerber does not have the balance beam on it. Suggested having the post colors changed to Purple. Burke pieces coloring suggestions: Satellite Climber to Tan, Spinner, and Rally Round to Purple. Balance beam also in Purple.

Cathy, Colleen and Principal Lindner will have a final meeting with Andy Stefancin after Home \& School meeting on the $18^{\text {th }}$ to finalize playground and place an order.

## Playground Update:

After the Special Meeting of Home \& School on February 4, 2014, which was based on the quote with the Burke Equipment for approximately $\$ 84,000.00$, the School District of New Berlin obtained another quote, dated February 7, 2014, with similar Gerber Leisure Equipment that was approximately $\$ 70,000.00$. The Home and School Executive Committee reviewed the difference and determined that the playground structure and pieces were similar in price but the major difference was in the installation and removal costs which were just over \$10,000 of the difference. The Home and School Executive Committee discussed and considered if the equipment quality was comparable and the preferred design of the different pieces and structures. The Gerber Leisure Equipment installation would be the same installers that installed the Gerber Leisure equipment in the Elmwood Northeast playground 10 years ago. After a lengthy conference call with the Gerber Leisure contractor, the Home and School Executive Committee proposed to have the main structure be Gerber Leisure but the additional standalone pieces be the Burke equipment preferred over the Gerber Leisure comparable pieces. The Gerber Leisure contractor can accept delivery of the Burke pieces and install them. The colors will be compatible and all warranties will be honored.

The Executive Committee of the Home and School will recommend to the School District of New Berlin to move forward with the Gerber Leisure main structure and Burke stand-alone pieces with Gerber Leisure contractors installing both with a final cost of approximately $\$ 73,000$.
Home \& School will allocate approximately $\$ 36,500$ to the purchase and installation of the new playground in the Summer of 2014.

e. Movie Night - March 7-6:15-8:15pm - Rescheduled to April $25^{\text {th }}$. Need to advertise 3 weeks before actual event.
