- II. Presentation and approval of minutes Presentation of November minutes for review. Item III, Entertainment Books were "under budget" and not "extra. Also, under Assembly Coordinator, Patty Snyder helped secure the PPG grant to bring the African Acrobats to Elmwood. Minutes could not be approved as quorum was not met. May have quorum at end of meeting, otherwise Table to next meeting.
- III. Financial report by Cathy Bartels Entertainment books were finalized and they were a little under budget. Shop Until You Drop over what was made last year. However, we have yet to receive the Custodian bill(we do share costs with Park and Rec from 9-2pm). \$3,400 was added to budget for Instruction and Technology(first grade purchased "Me Moves" kits to help settle kids down ready to learn). Principal Royce Lindner wants to order thru Scholastic, however a local bookstore will give about 20%. We'll probably have more than one order. Question raised about using \$2,400 for Co-curriculars. Principal Lindner is fairly certain we will. The district also informed from district that Elmwood now needs to kick in for Solo & Ensemble Festival Co-curricular contract (orchestra, etc.)
